

There is no need for prior registration at the hospital if you have already registered with Bangkok Hospital Udon and have an existing HN number.

**For Tricare Retirement's Patients:**

1. **At your first hospital visit each year, the hospital will collect a deposit towards your \$150 annual deductible.** If the cost of your treatment is less than \$150, we will only collect a deposit in the amount of the actual treatment cost. For any subsequent visits, we will continue collecting the remaining balance of your deductible until it totals \$150. Once your total medical expenses for the year reach \$150, no further deposits will be required. Please note that this deductible deposit is collected regardless of any prior visits to other hospitals. If TRICARE identifies that this \$150 deductible has already been paid elsewhere and has covered the full claim amount for your visit to Bangkok Hospital Udon, this deposit will be refunded to you.
2. **Patients are required to pay a 25% co-payment for each visit.**
3. The following documents are required for eligibility verification at Bangkok Hospital Udon:
  - Proof of long-term visa or permanent residency in Thailand, such as a visa certificate or house registration document.
  - Patients must prepare and provide their 9-digit Social Security Number (SSN) to the hospital.
4. **Patients must sign the TRICARE Retired Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) form provided by Bangkok Hospital Udon.** This MOU outlines that the patient is responsible for paying a portion of the total cost before TRICARE covers the remaining amount. The patient agrees to place a \$150 USD deductible as a deposit for medical or surgical procedure costs at the hospital. The hospital agrees to reimburse the \$150 USD deductible depending on the amount TRICARE reimburses to the hospital. The reimbursement will be paid or credited back to the patient based on their payment method.

**Additionally, the patient consents to pay any expenses if TRICARE denies partial or full coverage for medical expenses due to conditions not covered under the TRICARE plan.**
5. **Patients must complete the necessary information on the TRICARE Claim Form (CUI).**

## **For Veteran affair foreign medical program, (VA FMP) Patients**

**Bangkok Hospital Udon will accept OPD cases only if the medical expenses exceed 5,000 THB per bill. For IPD cases, there is no minimum medical expense requirement.**

1. The following documents are required for eligibility verification at Bangkok Hospital Udon:
  - Proof of long-term visa or permanent residency in Thailand, such as a visa certificate or house registration document.
  - A letter of VA FMP Benefits Authorization from the Department of Veterans Affairs, Foreign Medical Program Office, specifying the conditions covered (VA Adjudicated Service-Connected Conditions).

**The hospital can directly bill VA-FMP only for treatments related to the conditions listed in the letter.**

- **For treatments outside of the conditions specified in the FMP Benefits Authorization, the patient must pay the hospital directly. \*\***
- **A signed Letter for Payment Agreement to consent the hospital to collect expenses under the circumstance that the VA FMP partially or fully fails to cover the medical expenses.**
